## Recent reports from around the area:

The Texas Parks and Wildlife is now waiving normal fishing license and stamp requirements at all state parks in Texas, saltwater as well as freshwater. Texas State Parks are hosting "Free Fishing in State Parks" all year long to encourage folks to get out and do some fishing. Park entrance fees may still be required, but once you've paid to get in, you do not have to purchase a license or stamp as long as you are within park boundaries. Wade fishing in coastal state parks is permitted along park property, limits and other regulations will still be enforced. This time of year the sun can be brutal, so don't forget to wear sunscreen when you're out there trying to catch a big one!

**Bolivar** – Trout, black drum and reds are fair to good.

**Rollover Pass** – Black drum and reds are pretty good, trout are fair.

**West Bay** – Steady fishing in the Bay, especially for trout.

**Corpus Christi** – Nice trout, reds, and black drum are also good.

**Fat Boys Pier** – Big specks, red, drum and croakers.

**Corpus Christi** – Lots of trout, red fish and black drum.

**North Jetties** – Sheep head, flounder and a few reds.

**Sylvan Beach** – Some sheep head and a few reds.
